Tour Itinerary

Day 1 : Canada – Lima

Depart from Canada to Lima, the vibrant capital of Peru on the Pacific Coast.

Day 2 : Lima (B)

Upon arrival, embark on a city tour of Lima with its 2,000 years of history. Begin with the colonial centre of the city, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its historical buildings surrounding the splendid Plaza Mayor. View the impressive

Palace of the Archbishop with its finely carved balcony, the opulent Government Palace, the official residence of the President, and see the exterior of 16th-century



Cathedral of Lima whose first stone was laid by Pizarro. Check in hotel in the afternoon, the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 3 : Lima - Cusco - Indigenous farm - Pisac Market - Sacred Valley (B)

Today transfer to the airport for the flight to Cusco, then meet and greet by your tour guide upon arrival in Cusco. In order to avoid altitude sickness, we drive down to the Sacred Inca Valley (2,000m). On-route we visit an indigenous Alpaca and Llama co-op farm. Then take a scenic drive to Pisac Village. There, explore the town and bargain with vendors on the cobblestone streets of the Pisac handicraft market. Enjoy a cultural blast as the entire town has been converted into a street market. Afterward, continue to your hotel in the Sacred Valley.

Day 4 : Sacred Valley - Machu Picchu Village (B)

This morning, the Sacred Valley tour. Uncover the secrets of Moray, where the Inca's ingenious circular terraces reveal their mastery of agriculture and adaptation to high-altitude climates. Witness the mesmerizing salt ponds of Maras, glistening under the Andean sun as they have for centuries, and explore the majestic fortress of Ollantaytambo, where history comes alive in its stone terraces and sacred temples. Then transfer to Ollantaytambo Railway Station in the Sacred Valley and stroll through the ancient Inca Street before boarding the Inca Rail Train to Machu Picchu, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, known as "The Lost City of the Incas." Register at a nearby hotel. The town centre offers dining, shops, the Mercado Artisanal craft market, Los Jardines de Mandor gardens, and the Butterfly House conservation project. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Machu Picchu Village. Experience the stunning landscape through panoramic windows that showcase Peru's beauty in full view. This includes either the 360° Train or the Vista dome, subject to availability.

Day 5 : Machu Picchu - Cusco (B)

This morning, transfer to the Machu Picchu entrance, then you will have a guided walking tour of the sanctuary. Machu Picchu was built circa 1450 and abandoned only 100 years later. The purpose of this splendid city is still a mystery to modern historians. Enjoy exploring the ancient citadel and marvelling at the imposing Temple, the House of the Priest, the Sacred Plaza and the intricately carved rock likely used as a sundial by the ancient Incas. The images of this significant archaeological site will be a long-lasting memory. Afterwards, take the train to Ollantaytambo Station and then transfer back to your hotel in Cusco.

Day 6 : Cusco - San Blas Neighbourhood (B)

This morning, uncover Cusco, the former Inca capital, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, blending Incan and Spanish history. Walk the well-crafted Incan roads, starting from the central Plaza, and see the Colonial Cathedral housing 400+ Coquina School paintings and colonial art. Then you may elevate your adventure with walking tour to visit the Temple of the Sun. This significant Incan temple,



known as Coricancha in Quechua, was dedicated to Inti, the Sun God, and once adorned with gold panels and precious stones.

Explore the intricate stonework and learn about its importance as the centre of Incan religious ceremonies, showcasing the civilization's devotion and architectural mastery.

In the afternoon, Saqsayhuamán Inca ruin . Experience the grandeur of Saqsayhuamán, a fortress complex with colossal stone walls that display the remarkable craftsmanship of the Inca builders. The site's panoramic views over Cusco and its unique architecture make it an unmissable highlight that reveals the power and ingenuity of the ancient Inca civilization.

Day 7 : Cusco - Lima (B)

After breakfast, transfer to airport and fly to Lima. Upon arrival, transfer to hotel in Lima. Tonight, join the Magic Water and Fountains of. In a lush 19-acre nature reserve on the outskirts of Miraflores, Magic Water and Fountain Show is one of the most popular attractions in the city.

Day 8 : Lima (B)

Today join the Lima Museo Larco Tour. The Museo Larco is housed in an 18th century vicerealty mansion. Surrounded by beautiful gardens, the Museo Larco permanent exhibition invites visitors to explore the more than 5000 year history of ancient Peru, through a fascinating collection of pre-Columbian art.

Day 9 : Lima – Canada (B)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport for your flight back to Toronto.
